What is Xylitol?

- It is a plant derived alcohol that humans can tolerate but our canine friends cannot. It only takes a small amount for toxicity to occur.
- It is commonly found in chewing gum, lozenges, nasal sprays, some peanut butters, and other “natural remedies.”
 - Be sure to check the labels of any products that you leave out on your counter to make sure they do not contain Xylitol.
 - Xylitol is deadly. Commonly it causes low blood sugar, weakness, collapse, seizures, liver failure, and eventually death.
